

Lamb-Basham Memorial Chapel

Founded: 1891

Location: 226 East Washington Street, Oakland City (1909)

P. H. Lamb founded the Lamb Funeral Home & Livery Stable in 1891. The company changed names to Lamb & Son Funeral Home, when J. W. Lamb began operating the business with his father in 1909. J. W. discontinued the livery stable in 1925. In 1933, four years after the death of P. H. Lamb, Jack P. Lamb joined his father J. W. Lamb. Jack P. shared ownership with Edith Lamb by 1949. In 1998 Jerry Lee Basham owned the Lamb-Basham Memorial Chapel.
