

Riverview Hospital – Noblesville

Hamilton County's first hospital opened for business in 1909 when Dr. Samuel Harrell built the three-story Harrell Hospital and Sanatorium in downtown Noblesville, in which he and his brother Madison could practice medicine. Sold to Hamilton County in 1914, it also became the state's first county hospital.

Today, Riverview Hospital is one of the largest employers in Hamilton County and offers comprehensive healthcare services in more than 35 medical specialties, from its comprehensive Heart and Vascular Center and Emergency Center to services offered in its Women's Pavilion and Surgery Pavilion.
