

### **William Schaub & Co. – Indianapolis**

In 1909, William Schaub of Brownstown opened a store in Indianapolis specializing in potatoes, onions and cabbage. As his business grew, it became known for good quality produce, honesty and friendliness. Successful even through the thrifty times of the Great Depression and the civilian food shortages of World War II, William Schaub & Co. became a wholesale brokerage firm—saving the huge overhead costs of warehouses and transportation.

Today Bill and John Schaub, the family's fourth generation, continue to distribute potatoes and onions from all growing regions in the United States to Indiana, Michigan, Ohio, and Kentucky. This pioneering Indiana business still prospers and serves the Midwest with excellent quality produce.
