

## Young's Cafe

Founded: ca. 1911

Location: 855 E. Market St., Huntington

Young's Cafe has been in business over 100 years, in the same family and at the same location in Huntington, Indiana. The original license was issued on April 5, 1911. It was owned by Joe Young and it was called Young Brothers. Joe's brothers, Charlie and Ed also worked at the Bar. During Prohibition, the business was a meat market.

Floyd Young, Joe's son started working at the Bar in the mid 1930's. After Joe died in 1941, Floyd took the business over and the name was changed to Young's Hoosier Cafe. When Floyd became ill, his wife, Fern, started running the Cafe in 1963. Larry Young started working for his Mother, Fern, in April of 1968. When Fern retired in 1974, Larry and his wife Sharon bought the business. When the business Incorporated in 1987, the name was changed to Young's Cafe Inc.

Larry Young retired in 2005, but he and his wife, Sharon, still own the business. Their son, Danny, has been working at the Bar since 2000 and is the Manager and their daughter, Susan, has also been working there since 2000. Young's Cafe is a friendly neighborhood bar serving beer, liquor, wine, soft drinks and food.
