HISTORICAL SKETCH

The Current Discussion Club was formed in 1920 by a group of Northside Indianapolis women, many with ties to Shortridge High School. Its purpose was "the discussion of current and literary topics." Membership was limited to twenty-five, and election was by secret ballot. Dues were minimal. Members were expected to present a paper once every two years.

Meetings were held mainly in members' homes, and usually included "a delicious luncheon." The first meeting of the year often included a bridge game, and the last was often a picnic including husbands and other guests. Among the club's members at different times were author Jeannette C. Nolan and the wives of Mayor John W. Kern, Methodist Bishop Frederick D. Leete, city planner Lawrence V. Sheridan, and insurance executive Weber D. Donaldson.

In addition to papers by members, programs through the years included visiting speakers such as the president of the League of Women Voters and the secretary of the YWCA. One year the club attended a session of the General Assembly. As the membership aged and changed, the club held its last formal meeting in 1986.

SCOPE AND CONTENT

This collection, filling two manuscript boxes, contains minutes of the club 1920-1986 complete except for 1974-1980, and a nearly complete set of yearbooks for the years 1934-1986. There are also retrospective accounts written for the twenty-fifth and fiftieth anniversaries of the club, and several versions of the constitution and bylaws.
