Jane Stout Fribley graduated from Indiana University in 1938. She has been active in many organizations, especially in the church and in the women's movement. She has served as the National Secretary and as State Legislative Citizen Action Chair for Church Women United, as President of the Indiana Council of Churches, and as State Coordinator of the Religious Committee for the ERA. In addition she is a member of the League of Women Voters, the Women's Political Caucus and has served on the Indiana Civil Rights Commission.

SCOPE AND CONTENT NOTE

This collection contains papers related to the various organizations Ms. Fribley has been active in, especially those concerned with the passage of the Equal Rights Amendment.
